



SRUC Edinburgh Campus Accommodation

At SRUC Edinburgh we do not have our own Halls of Residence. We recommend many of the private student Halls of Residence offered all over the City.

You will find a list of these on our website –I can confirm that they are very modern, clean and designed to high specification with a range of en-suite rooms and studios from single occupancy to shared units, together with non-en-suite rooms with larger shared bathrooms.

All have CCTV, 24-hour Warden Services, laundry facilities, communal lounge areas.

There are also organised quiz nights, barbeques etc.

Included in the price are all utility bills, in-room internet access, and basic contents insurance.

Majority are close to Kings Buildings Campus whether it be on a direct bus route, within walking distance or perhaps you may be using a bike to travel to College.

As we are the Capital city the rent does reflect this, but for students and particularly parents seeing their child off to college for the first time, they do offer safety and security which is invaluable.

Collegiate at McDonald Road seems to be a firm favourite with past students. When making initial contact, please mention that you will be studying at SRUC – wherever possible they try and pair up other SRUC students at the same accommodation, again a nice touch - they may even be on the same course as you!!!

Students can apply for accommodation at any time, and you do not need to wait until you have a confirmed place at SRUC. The application process is online via the providers own website: currently many are taking a booking fee of approx £100.00. No more monies are paid until you are actually in situ.

Alternatively, some students choose to rent accommodation within the city's private rental sector. Edinburgh has a large student population and a large rental market, so finding a room to rent as part of a flat-share, or even a flat to rent alone, is very rarely a problem. Approx £350+ a month, may include bills or not.
