

Student Transport – Riverside Campus



Public Transport

The Riverside Campus is well served by public transport links. Ayr train station is under 10 minutes' walk from the campus. There is a half hourly train service between Ayr and Glasgow Central with a journey time of just over 40 minutes.

Stagecoach is the local bus operator and runs bus services into Ayr and the town centre from surrounding areas and further afield - timetables can be found on the [Stagecoach website](#).

Traveling by Car

Parking at Ayr Campus is limited for students during the day on a first come first served basis, and, as there is little capacity for on-street parking in the area, you are advised to make use of public transport to the campus or to car-share as much as possible. Blue badge holders are able to access dedicated spaces in car parks 1 and 2.

UWS and SRUC enjoy a close relationship with the local community and we ask students not to park on the Craigie Estate or Holmston Road due to the disruption this can cause to local residents. South Ayrshire Council monitor parking on the streets around the Campus and are likely to apply penalties to those parking illegally. If you are unable to park on the Campus you can access parking in Ayr town centre.
