Edinburgh Campus – Student Travel



By road

Our Edinburgh campus lies 3 miles (5 km) to the south of the city centre, within the King's Buildings campus of the University of Edinburgh. The campus is a 20-minute taxi journey from the city centre.

By bus

The campus is on a city bus route which is served by a variety of buses. The Lothian Buses 41 route comes onto campus, buses 24, 38 and 42 stop nearby. The 67 runs from Hanover Street to the Bush Estate via Straiton Park & Ride.

By bike

The surrounding roads are a comfortable cycle. Further information is given on the **Edinburgh City Council website**. We have a secure bike park on Campus.

By rail

Services to/from Edinburgh Waverley Station connect with towns and cities throughout the United Kingdom.

By Air

Edinburgh has an international and domestic airport on the west side of the city. The airport has a regular bus service which takes passengers to the centre of the city, as well as an airport taxi service.

Parking

We do not have student car parking facilities on Campus, however a permit can be obtained from Edinburgh University's Parking department. Details of which can be obtained from the Education Office 0131 535 4041 – jenny.thomson@sruc.ac.uk.
