Living on Campus

Students aged 16 or above can apply to stay in College accommodation during term time.

Under NO circumstances can under 16's stay on the Campus.

Catered Meal Option is available to **ALL** residential students. For students eligible to apply for Further Education Bursary Funding, the cost of Catered accommodation will automatically be assessed.

Standard Accommodation comprises a furnished bedroom and shared communal areas.

Communal areas in each residence are supplied with a microwave, kettle and fridge/freezer.

Meals are provided in the College refectory known as 'Eating Place'.

En-suite Accommodation comprises apartment blocks providing accommodation for 4-6 students, each with en-suite private bedrooms, a shared kitchen and living area.

To live in En-suite Accommodation you must be 18 years old by the end of September 2020.

Each apartment block is supplied with a fully fitted kitchen/ dining room containing:

- Cooker
- Toaster
- Fridge/freezer
- Microwave
- Kettle
- Vacuum cleaner

You must provide your own:

- Food
- Crockery
- Linen
- Cutlery
- Cooking utensils
- TV (including a Valid TV Licence)

Bedding - all students must provide their own bed linen (all beds are single size):

- Pillows
- Duvet
- Sheets
- Pillow Cases

Other linens

- Towels
- Tea towels will also be required for students in self-catering accommodation.
